

## **Feedback on Curriculum 2020-2021:**

The feedback on the curriculum was collected from different stakeholders such as students, alumni, faculty, and parents. The feedback is analysed and valuable suggestions given were considered and necessary actions were executed.

### **Student's feedback-**

- Feedback analysis clearly indicates that more than 80% of students are very much satisfied with attainment of programme outcomes, flexibility on curriculum, teaching-learning process, teaching infrastructure, library resources, laboratory facilities, industrial visits/field trips, students support mechanism etc. offered by the Institution.

### **Parent's feedback-**

- It is observed that most of the parents are satisfied with the curriculum as revealed from the examination of the feedback collected for the session 2020-2021. Parents consider that course program is very good and can be completed on time. They also have a good opinion with the quality and relevance of courses, test and reference books in market, quality of teaching and evaluation system of the college.

### **Alumni feedback-**

- Alumni of this college have appreciated the college ambience, relevance and quality of syllabus, Library resources and evaluation system and quality of teaching in the college. Some alumni consider that, Infrastructure and Lab facilities in the college are average and need to be upgraded.

### **Teacher's feedback-**

- From feedback analysis it is observed that 98% teachers say that the current syllabus is need based and the programmes outcomes, programmes specific outcomes and course outcomes of the syllabi is well defined. On an average 90% teachers are satisfied with the current syllabus designed by Himachal Pradesh University.
- 100% of the teachers have opinion that the syllabus is suitable to the course and aims and objective of the syllabus are well defined and clear. Only 4.65% of the teachers consider that syllabus is not need based. Most of the teachers supported the fact that there is a good balance between theory and application.
- 91% of the teachers agree that the environment in the college is conducive to teaching and research.

### **Analysis of feedback from suggested-**

- More facilities and infrastructure in the college for research activity is required.
- Library facilities must be augmented to meet the current requirement of the students to enable efficient learning.
- Faculty-student interaction may be enhanced. Smart class programmes may be made effective.
- Capacity building programmes may be organised for staff for upgrading their skill and professional development.
